The children/staff have benefited from having sports coaches deliver sessions during the year, including skipping workshops and swimming lessons taught by a qualified instructor for all classes. This will be sustainable in the future as many of the staff were working alongside the coaches and therefore developed their own CPD. The swimming team also took part in extra sessions at a local swimming pool to train for the HASP swimming gala.

Extra-Curriculum Enrichment

£2828

This has enabled us to provide after school clubs, such as, football, netball, table tennis, tag rugby, multi skills and tennis. It has helped us to offer the children more opportunity to engage in a variety of sporting activities with 51% of children participating in sports clubs. We have also attended various local sporting events throughout the year to compete against local schools (football, netball, tag rugby, tennis, swimming and cross country).

Developing the outside area

£3115

We developed the area around the swimming pool including a raised patio. Repairs were made to our playground climbing frame. We also purchased equipment for the children to use during playtimes, such as, bats, balls, skipping ropes and spades and trowels for digging.

We achieved the Sports Mark Gold award this year.
